About the property

The Naringaningalook Grassland Reserve is located at 1259 Loofs Road, 15 km east of Numurkah. This section of land was purchased by Trust for Nature in 1999 with funding from the Australian Government's National Reserve System Program.

This reserve protects two endangered ecological vegetation communities, Plains Woodland and Plains Grassy Woodland/Gilgai Wetland Mosaic. Currently, within Northern Victoria only 0.5% of the original extent of Plains Grasslands remain.

The structure and diversity of this reserve is unique in the Goulburn Broken catchment with 127 flora species being recorded, including a range of seasonal dependent species.

The site is registered on the National Estate. The protection of this reserve contributes significantly to the conservation of Northern Plains grasslands in the Goulburn Broken catchment.





Naringaningalook Grassland Reserve is habitat forever

Key habitats: Plains Woodlands and Plains Grassy Woodland/ Gilgai Wetland Mosaic

Notable flora species: Yellow-tongue Daisy (*Brachyscome chrysoglossa*), Silky Swainson-pea (*Swainsona serica*), Woolly Buttons (*Leiocarpa panaetioides*), Water Starwort (*Callitriche umbonata*), Native Peppergrass (*Lepidium pseudohyssopifolium*) and Dwarf Bluebush (*Maireana humillima*)

Notable fauna species: Tree Goanna (*Varanus varius*), Striped Legless Lizard (*Delmar impar*), Little Button-quail (*Turnix velox*), Spotted Harrier (*Circus assimilis*) and Copper Butterfly (*Lucia limbaria*)




