



Kinypanial Grassland (woolshed) Reserve

Management priorities include high threat weed control such as African Boxthorn, Gazania and Thistles. To maintain the open grassland to manage exotic annual species, strategic grazing is undertaken after the autumn break until late winter.

About the property

The Kinypanial Grassland (woolshed) Reserve was acquired by Trust for Nature in 1999 with the support of the Commonwealth Government's Natural Heritage Trust – through the National Reserve System Program.

This site located north east of Wedderburn protects a substantial area of Northern Plains Grasslands Community. This vegetation community is listed as threatened in Victoria under the state Flora and Fauna Guarantee Act 1988. This vegetation is regarded as being very high priority for conservation within the Riverina Plain and as such is listed as endangered within the local area.

The reserve protects a number of state listed species. This includes Hairy Tails (*Ptilotus erubescens*) and Buloke (*Allocasuarina luehmannii*).

In a landscape which is predominantly used for high impact grazing and cropping, the importance of the permanent protection of this site is further highlighted.

Key habitats: Plains Grassland and Plains Woodland

Notable flora species: Small Vanilla-lily (*Arthropodium minus*), Hairy Tails (*Ptilotus erubescens*), Buloke (*Allocasuarina luehmannii*), Grey Box (*Eucalyptus microcarpa*) and Rye Beetle-grass (*Tripogon loliiformis*)

Notable fauna species: Tessellated Gecko (*Diplodactylus tessellatus*), Little Button-quail (*Turnix velox*), Sun Moth (*Synemon* sp c.f. *selene*), Fat-tailed Dunnart (*Sminthopsis crassicaudata*) and Black-Shouldered Kite (*Elanus axillaris*)



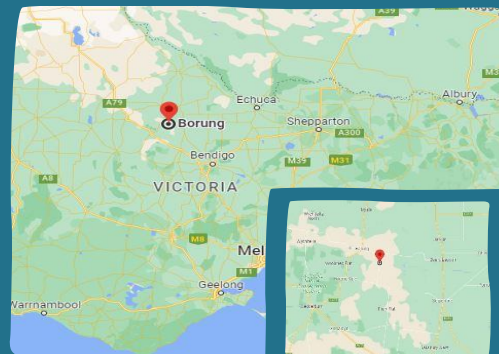
